

## REMEMBER:

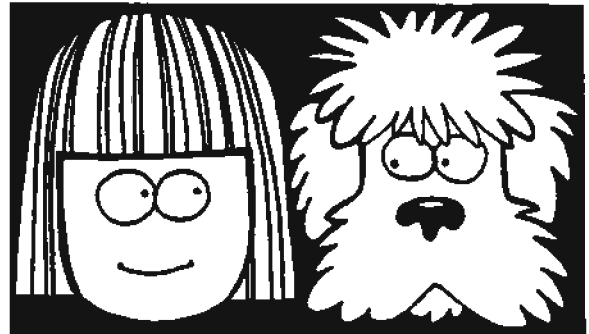
- HELP DOGS FEEL SAFE AROUND YOU BY MOVING SLOWLY AND TALKING QUIETLY.

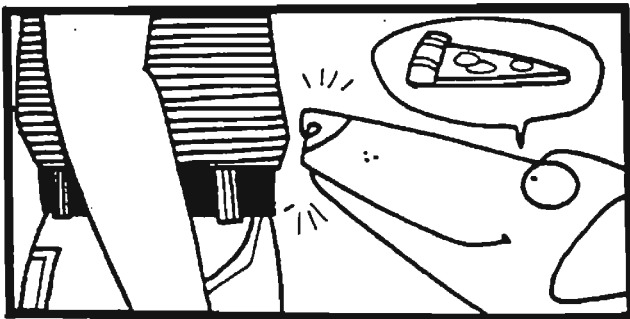

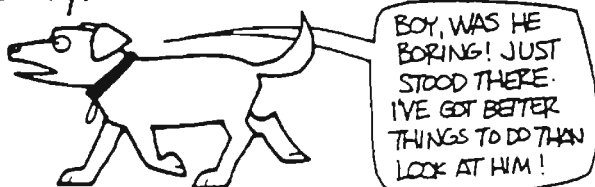


HOW TO BE SAFE AROUND DOGS

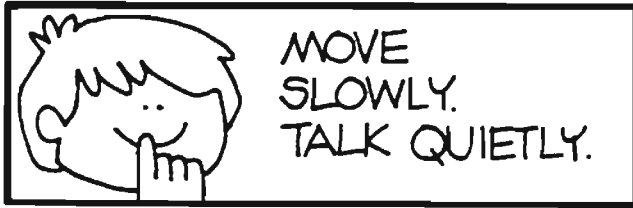
ALWAYS ASK PERMISSION BEFORE TOUCHING SOMEONE ELSE'S DOG.

A good way to be safe around dogs is to help them feel safe around you.

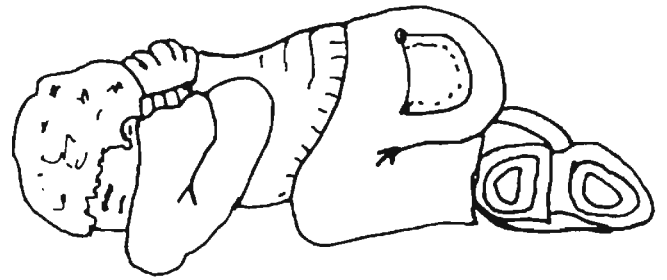

DO NOT TURN YOUR BACK WHILE THE DOG IS STILL THERE.

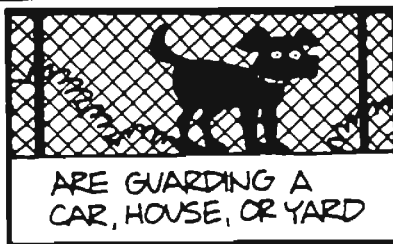
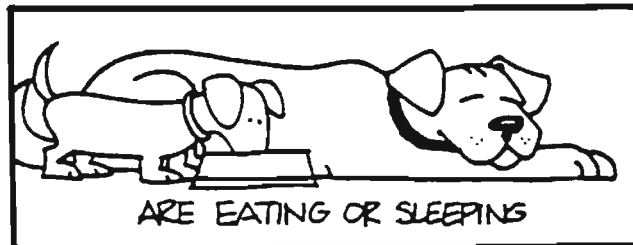
DO NOT RUN AWAY FROM THE DOG. THIS WILL MAKE IT WANT TO CHASE YOU.

If a dog knocks you down, curl into a ball and protect your face. Wait like this until the dog leaves or someone comes to help you.



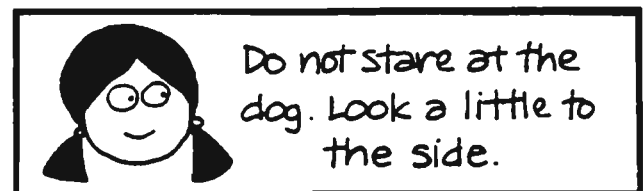
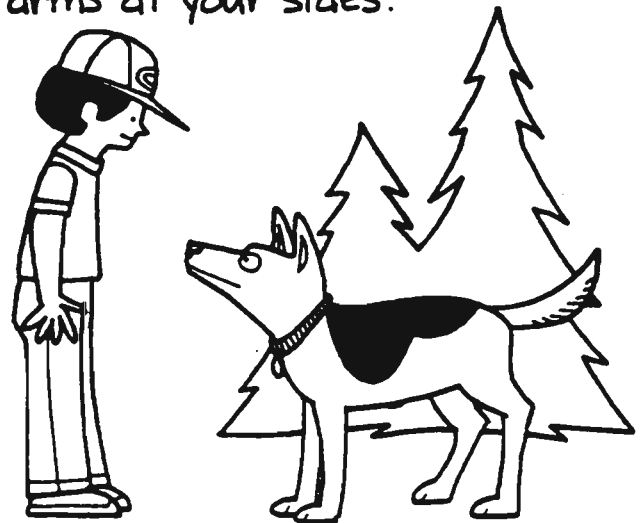
